## **GUIDANCE NOTES**

Please complete this form if you are building more than one new property that will require an address, for example new houses, steading conversion, block of flats or business premises. The Council will allocate the official address following liaison with Royal Mail as appropriate.

We will inform various agencies of the new address(es), this includes the emergency services, Ordnance Survey, utility companies and Scottish Assessors.

It may take several months for the address to show on all third-party databases. This is because companies download Royal Mail data at different intervals throughout the year.

If the new property development includes one or more new streets, you can suggest names for the streets and these will be considered by the local Aberdeenshire Councillors in conjunction with the relevant Community Council. Note that it generally takes 3-4 weeks to register a new single property and 8-12 weeks to register street names and numbering in a new development.

You must supply a location map and site layout plan showing the new properties, preferably in AutoCAD compatible DWG/DXF format.
