#### **Directions**

The route runs through Ellon along the western edge of the town and can be accessed at various points. In the centre of the town, pedestrian access is available from both the north and south banks of the riverside path. Access is also available from either side of Station Road, or via the link path on Hospital Road. Ramped access is available at the access point on Riverside Road at the south western edge of the town.

Auchnagatt is a charming Aberdeenshire village and you can see traces of railway station that was once there.



Haddo House is situated within Haddo Country Park and is located 8 miles west of Ellon on easily cycled quiet roads. The house is managed by the National Trust for Scotland. Originally designed by William Adam in 1732, it boasts beautiful gardens, Georgian architecture, a superb collection of famous paintings, a lovely shop and period tearoom.

- Take a picnic to Haddo House and enjoy the stunning gardens, walks and wildlife.
- Take your binoculars and watch some of our native species of birds and butterflies.


