Access to the route at Longside is found north of the main centre of the village by Auchlee Bridge and Station Terrace. At Peterhead access to the route is found on York Street. This is close to the community centre on Queen Street. The access is between two houses.

Peterhead is home to one of the

largest Scottish North Sea fishing fleets. The harbour is lively and bustling, full of colourful boats entering and leaving the harbour at all times of the



day. Explore the maritime past of Peterhead at the Arbuthnott Museum, one of Aberdeenshire's oldest museums.

Peterhead is the wildlife enthusiasts dream with many coastal habitats for a wide variety of bird species. These can be seen at the mouth of the river Ugie on the north side of Peterhead.

Hints and Tips


- Discover the abundance of wildlife along the Peterhead coastline.
