Directions

The Formartine & Buchan Way begins at Dyce Railway Station. Access to the line is from the far right corner of the station car park situated off Station Road. Station Road is accessed from Victoria Street, the main road running north to south through Dyce.



There is an abundance of wildlife along the walk and you can see many buzzards swooping down from the trees, whilst flocks of redwing and fieldfare can be spotted along the route.

Beyond Newmachar take a rest and enjoy the distinctive view of Bennachie to the west.




- Take your binoculars as you can spot some interesting varieties of birds.
