BANFF OPTION C

- If the school are to use the Deveron Terrace tennis courts and/or football pitch this provides a great skive for the pupils! If Option C is adopted I would skive suggest providing a pavement from access/entry to proposed paved path towards bypass
- I'll like to see some actual sizes. I also feel a closer look is needed with the layout seeing as it does not fit need of current community centre users
- Limit in scope with a number of facilities not included. Option B certainly seems to be the better option
- I prefer Option C as it leaves existing rugby pitch at the academy
- Do not see the benefit of moving sports to a separate site
- All weather pitch to be 3G for rugby use. The provision of 3G surface, with rugby posts would facilitate training
- Equal access to floodlight pitches must be offered to all groups
- The indoor sports halls are made equally available to all sports clubs in the area at affordable cost
- No to Deveron Terrace already losing 1 green space
- With regards to Deveronside JFC Option C is the best option. I would go with an all weather pitch here to create a legacy for the youth footballers coming through in the town for generations to come
- Would be a reasonable option
- Upper balcony – extended for squash courts – seating behind glass backs – 2 courts

- A fair division of facilities. Arts Centre needs upgrading and more use
- Don't think this is feasible spending 2.5m on another site
- Extra cost of this could be used better elsewhere

- No Why spend millions extra on an ill-sited pitch. It is a good idea to have pitches in Macduff as well which answers the issue of having all in one place
- Preferred option for Banff – good to see a running track
- Slight alterations for spectators (seating couple rows fixed), small balcony for watching
- Can't see Banff Academy staff taking pupils down to Deveron Terrace to use the facilities – it would be going back to the 60s when we had to go down to Duff House grounds for football/hockey, etc as there were no facilities at the old Banff Academy. Another concern would be the safety of young folk going there at night/winter. Only parking is the current parking for Duff House
- Prefer this option with tennis courts no longer in schools grounds but could they not be situated at Princess Royal
- The proposed Deveron Centre (common to both options) will provide much needed enhanced facilities
- Sports facilities should be concentrated at the academy. Extremely costly to develop Deveron Terrace
- Did not like
- This is the best option because it includes everything
- Good enough but still think Option B is the better one

- Football pitches in good location, however, would be better in one location and within reach of other facilities
- Why break facilities – spend money on end product instead of digging out a hill
- Why does Banff need both options? Banff £9.2m, Macduff £3.1m WHY?
- Move near town centre and public may be more willing to go
- Sensory garden in landscaped area. Skate Park? Favourite option
- Youth room should be downstairs – closer to café and us youth then to come in and out most of the day, less hassle
- This has always been a bit of a strange choice to put these facilities in a field with a slope – waste of money to make it flat before you even start!!
- Best option. All options need larger fitness suite. Small fitness suites are intimidating for unfit and overweight
- Good idea not having tennis courts in school area. Could they not be situated at Princess Royal?
- Having a community room between aerobics and fitness suite seems silly – sound pollution from both. NEEDS MORE STORAGE for all kits belonging to sports and community groups. Youth space upstairs would be received better and used more by teenagers if a ground floor space and near café facilities. Also then would be closer to reception for monitoring. Don't tuck it away in an upstairs corner of the building
- Community engagement for non-sports groups needs looking at
- Second best but would be better with tennis courts at Academy
- Pavilion no facilities to sit down and watch the sports or purchase food and drinks
- Like this by far as the best. Possible to have a sense garden included in the landscaped bit at Deveron Park
