


What changes are coming to Council Tax charges?

National changes to Council Tax

A Scottish Parliament change to how Council Tax is calculated will result in an increase in Council Tax for Bands E-H.

Local changes to Council Tax

There may be up to a 3% rise in Council Tax. That rise will be decided at a local level, for spending within Aberdeenshire.



How does this affect me?

The table below shows how the changes may affect each of the Council Tax Bands*:
