



Increasing population*




Our population in Aberdeenshire grew by 11.5% between 2003 and 2013. It is expected that it will grow by a further 9% by 2024.


Education services



Each year we transport around 10,500 pupils to school. It costs us £1,500 per pupil per year.

The number of school meals served has risen from

2.7 million in 2005/2006 to 3.6 million in 2015/2016
