LIMITATION OF CANDIDATES' ELECTION EXPENSES – REGULATED PERIOD

The amount given below is based on (£8,700 +) 9p for every entry in the register of electors to be used at the election as at Friday, 5th May, 2017, being the last day for publication of the Notice of Election. It is the figure you should use for the calculation of your expenses.

It must be stressed that these amounts are <u>maximum</u> amounts and that, in addition to verifying the relevant calculation given below (the accuracy of which is not guaranteed), candidates and their election agents <u>must</u> ascertain the amounts applicable to themselves by reference to the relevant legislation.

In accordance with Sections 81 and 82 of the Representation of the People Act 1983, as amended, the election agent of every candidate, or the candidate where no agent has been appointed, <u>must</u> deliver a return of election expenses to the Returning Officer within thirty-five days after the day on which the result was declared. Saturdays, Sundays and holidays are included for this purpose and accordingly, the last date for the receipt of returns is Friday, 14th July, 2017. Where an election agent has been appointed, both the candidate and the agent must make this declaration.

Where a candidate has incurred no expenses, a return to this effect must still be made.

When the returns from the various candidates have been received, they will be retained for public inspection for the statutory period.
