What is Cafe Connect?

- Cafe Connect is a Internet Cafe initiative that provides a stepping stone to individuals with Learning & Physical Disabilities, Mental Health or Head Injuries to enter private or public sector employment.
- The cafe opened to the public in April 2010 and in a very short time its presence within the community has increased in many positive ways.
- There are currently 15 project members who have been referred through Aberdeenshire Council's Robertson Road Resource Centre, Mental Health & Disability Employment Officers.

Inspiration

Within Fraserburgh a need was identified for a locally integrated facility providing employment and personal development opportunities for adults with disabilities. A partnership was formed with Aberdeenshire Council and Fraserburgh Community Web (FCW) which led to the development of the Cafe Connect project.



Acheivements

- Good working partnership between Aberdeenshire Council and FCW.
- Opening to the Public
- 2009 Community Regeneration, Surf Award
- Project members building skills, confidence, teamwork & social skills
- Promoting independence
- Providing IT services to the community that are not readily available.

Funding

- A Service Level Agreement with Aberdeenshire Council & Fraserburgh Community Web enables the continued work in the Cafe initiative as well as work towards the development of positive links within the community.
- Daily income from Cafe and IT Services is put back into the project.
- Grants from Aberdeenshire Councils Community Asset Fund and Banff & Buchan Arts
 Forum have enabled the project to invest in new equipment for a physical and online
 gallery space within the Cafe.





The Future

- Increasing the support that the project can give other community groups and businesses.
- College courses and further skill development for the Project Members.
- Installation of a professional hanging system individuals and groups will be able to show/sell their artwork in an affordable public space.
