

- 1** Woodston Fishing Station has an ice house cut in the cliff used in the 19th century for packing salmon.
- 2** St Cyrus Village commands magnificent views over the coastline.
- 3** St Cyrus National Nature Reserve is a special place for shoreline plants and wide variety of sea birds. There is a visitor centre on the reserve.
- 4** The North Esk river forms the boundary between Aberdeenshire and Angus and runs for 30 miles from the Angus Glens to the North Sea at the southern end of St Cyrus beach.
