- 1 Charles Brae was the resting place for Bonnie Prince Charlie's retreating Jacobites in 1746.
- 2 Little remains of the Seagreens harbour which used to import coal and export lime.
- 3 Miltonhaven foreshore features the remains of Limekilns among the spectacular coloured boulders. Before quarrying, a band of limestone formed a great sea wall protecting the now lost village.
- 4 The gaunt ruined tower is the only remains of Kaim of Mathers Castle which was once 40ft square and four storeys high.
- 5 Woodston Fishing Station has an ice house cut in the cliff used in the 19th century for packing salmon.
- 6 St Cyrus Village commands magnificent views over the coastline.
