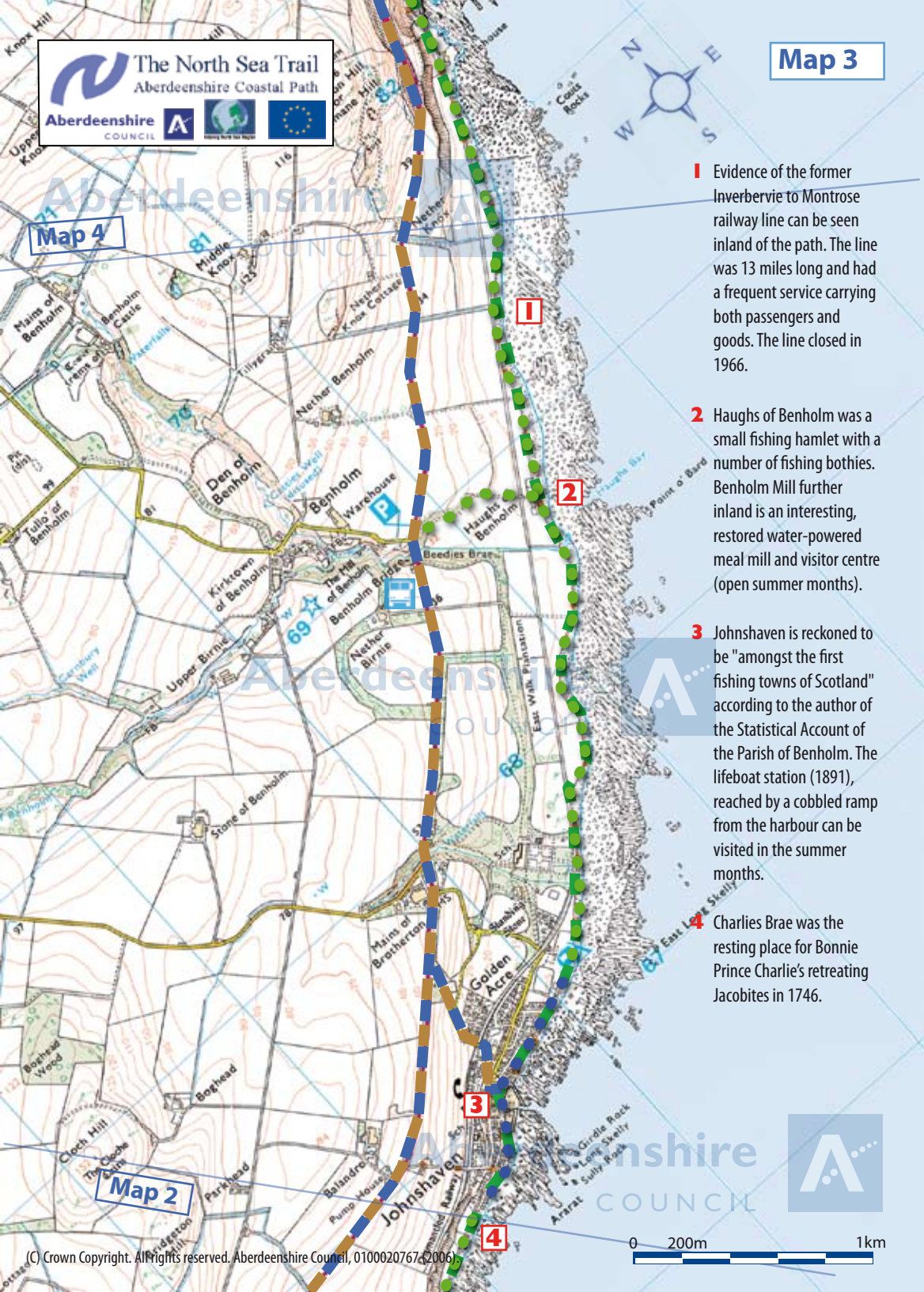

- 1** Evidence of the former Inverbervie to Montrose railway line can be seen inland of the path. The line was 13 miles long and had a frequent service carrying both passengers and goods. The line closed in 1966.
- 2** Haughs of Benholm was a small fishing hamlet with a number of fishing bothies. Benholm Mill further inland is an interesting, restored water-powered meal mill and visitor centre (open summer months).
- 3** Johnshaven is reckoned to be "amongst the first fishing towns of Scotland" according to the author of the Statistical Account of the Parish of Benholm. The lifeboat station (1891), reached by a cobbled ramp from the harbour can be visited in the summer months.
- 4** Charles Brae was the resting place for Bonnie Prince Charlie's retreating Jacobites in 1746.
