- 1 Buchanan Ness Lighthouse stands on the most easterly point in Scotland. It was built in 1827 with the red bands being added in 1907 to distinguish it as a day mark.
- 2 Only the fragmentary ruins remain of Boddam Castle, the seat of the Keiths of Ludquham.

- 3 Peterhead pink and grey granite was quarried from the cliffs between Boddam and Longhaven as can be witnessed by the granite built remains of engine houses, bothies and explosive stores. The quarry faces have reverted to nature and are now used as nesting sites for the wide variety of native seabirds.
