



- 1** The Waters of Philorth Local Nature Reserve is a pleasant place to walk or just sit and enjoy. The reserve is open all year round with footpaths providing access to Fraserburgh beach - a 3 mile stretch of golden sands.
- 2** Maggie's Hoosie, in Inverallochy, is a unique preserved fisher cottage that survives as a reminder of a bygone age. It is the last remaining example of this type of cottage, in its traditional condition.
- 3** Inverallochy airfield was commissioned in 1941 for aircrew training. In 1944 it became a Coastal Command airstation flying Warwick air sea rescue aircraft. These supported the Mosquito anti shipping strike wing based at Banff when on missions to Norway.
