- 1** Sandhaven – The huge but now largely derelict Harbour is a reminder of the 19th Century herring fishing boom. The former Forbes boatyard produced ocean going racing yachts as well as fishing boats. The Sandhaven meal mill, museum is a reminder that all villages had a mill for grinding oats. This one man operated mill was in production up to the 1970s.
- 2** The Fraserburgh Heritage Centre illustrates the rich history of this north-east Scottish fishing town. Exhibits commemorate famous sons of the town such as Thomas Blake Glover, the Japanese industrialist, and Bill Gibb the fashion designer.
- 3** Kinraid Head Lighthouse was the first lighthouse to be erected on the Scottish mainland. It is now home to the Museum of Scottish Lighthouses and boasts the largest collection of lighthouse equipment in the UK.
- 4** The Fraserburgh Seashore Centre provides information about the natural environment of the Fraserburgh Bay area.
