



1 Boyne castle 1575–80 now a picturesque but dangerous ruin (do not enter) was the home of Lord Deskford and replaced an earlier castle at the mouth of the Boyne burn. The castle was inhabited up to 1723 when the family finally moved to Cullen house.

2 Inland, the huge turbines of the Boyndie Airfield windfarm mark the location of the 2nd war airfield which was the base for the Banff strike wing. In the winter of 1944–45, Mosquito aircraft manned by mixed Norwegian, RAF and commonwealth crews flew many successful missions against enemy shipping in the Norwegian fjords.
