

GLOSSARY

Waste Management

Household Waste & Recycling Centre (HWRC)

A staffed site with a collection of recycling facilities for depositing recyclates. HWRCs usually accept a wider range of waste materials than Recycling Points and include other facilities, such as normal household waste disposal. Previously known as Civic Amenity Sites.

Recycling Points

An unstaffed site with containers for depositing recyclates, e.g. at a supermarket car park. Previously known as bring sites or bottle banks.

Recycling Bulking Point

An area where kerbside recycling vehicles unload the segregated recyclates for bulking up and loading for onward transport to reprocessors or for baling. This normally constitutes a concreted area with a selection of storage bays or large boxes and weighbridge facilities.

Waste Transfer Station

A facility where waste is compacted and bulked for onward transportation for treatment or disposal. Usually a covered area with an industrial type compactor.
