Aberdeenshire Council has prepared a Local Development Plan Main Issues Report (LDPMIR) together with associated documents, comprising the Monitoring Statement and Interim Environmental Report of the Strategic Environmental Assessment.

The LDPMIR and the associated documents set out a series of options on future development patterns and policies to promote and manage development in Aberdeenshire. It is expected to be the main focus of consultation and engagement on the Local Development Plan.
