Booking Conditions/Information

3. The management reserves the right to cancel any booking without prior notice although every effort will be made to give at least three days notice. In such instance alternate dates/times may be offered or full refund made.
4. In the event of the hirer having to cancel, this must be done in writing to the manager, Alford Snowsports Centre. In the event of cancellation by the hirer with less than 30 days notice, refunds are not available unless the facilities can be re-let.
5. The hirer, as named and signed on this form, is responsible for ensuring that all persons participating in the hire comply with the rules and regulations of the centre and instructions from centre staff and particular attention to safety and behavior.
6. The management reserves the right to refuse admission to the centre of any person at any time.

Safety

1. In the interest of safety, please ensure that all persons wishing to participate on the artificial slope come adequately clothed. Gloves, long sleeves and long trousers must be worn for protection at all times.
2. Snow poles are not to be used on the slope unless fitted with rubber guards.
3. All children under 10 years of age must wear ski helmets.
4. Anybody skiing or snowboarding in a manner likely to endanger others will be asked to leave the slope.
5. Aberdeenshire council accepts no responsibility for personal injury or loss or damage to property which may occur whilst at the centre
