This is due to the shallow end being sectioned off. When supervising more than one child both children must remain in the shallow end and must be wearing armbands or a swim aid unless they can swim at the competent swimmer level.

The Competent swimmer level is specified in a leaflet at reception and on posters on the notice board and pool side

No snorkels, masks, hand paddles or fins allowed.

Last admission 30 minutes prior to the the end of the session. Admission is 5 minutes prior to the start of each session.

Buzzers will be sounded 5 minutes before the end of the session.
