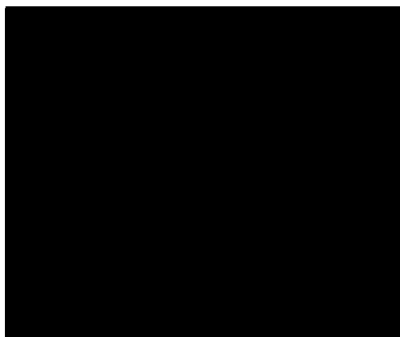
With reference to your email of 7 August 2014 I note below our response to the above.

Despite the publication of the 2014 Housing Land Audit and Strategic Development Plan for the area, it is vital for the Council through this new Local Development Plan to ensure that there is enough housing land in Inverurie to meet the needs of the community. The town suffers from too few house builders and too many proposed large executive type houses. The Local Development Plan needs to identify land, even if it is in addition to the requirement set out in the SDP, for family housing for the town.
