### Election of Councillor

2. Completed nomination forms **must** be delivered to one of the offices named above no later than **4.00pm** on **Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2017**.
3. Unless uncontested, an election will be held in the ward and voting will take place between **7.00am and 10.00pm** on **Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2017**.
4. Applications to register to vote at this election **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen, AB16 5GE, by **Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2017**.

#### Postal or proxy voting

1. Any elector may apply for a postal or proxy vote at this election.
2. Applications to vote by post, to cancel or alter postal and proxy votes, or to change from postal to proxy voting at this election **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by **5.00pm** on **Wednesday, 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2017**.
3. Applications to vote by proxy at this election **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen, AB16 5GB, by **5.00pm** on **Wednesday, 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2017**.

4. Applications for emergency proxy votes **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by **5.00pm on the date of the poll** and are available for anyone who:
  - (i) suffers an illness or disability after the deadline for proxy applications on Wednesday, 4 October, 2017; or
  - (ii) discovers, after that deadline, that they will be unavoidably absent from their qualifying address on the day of the election; or
  - (iii) discovers after that deadline that they will be unable to go to the poll on the day of the election for occupational, employment or service reasons.
