



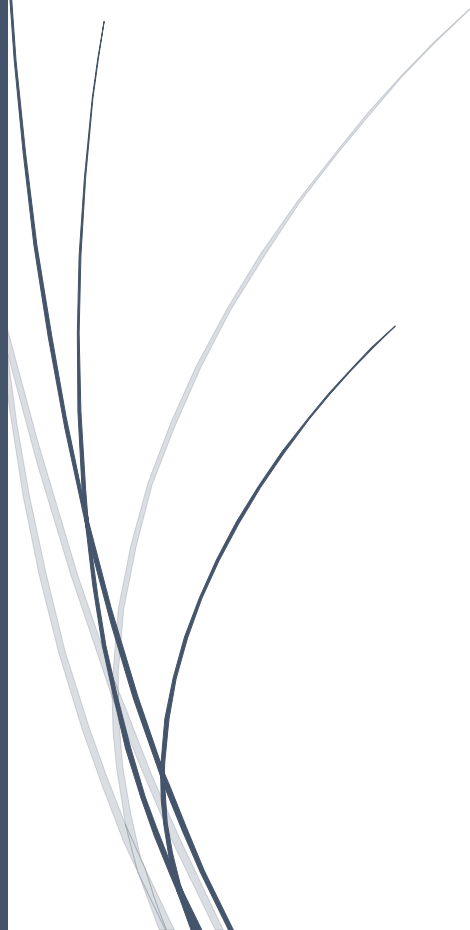

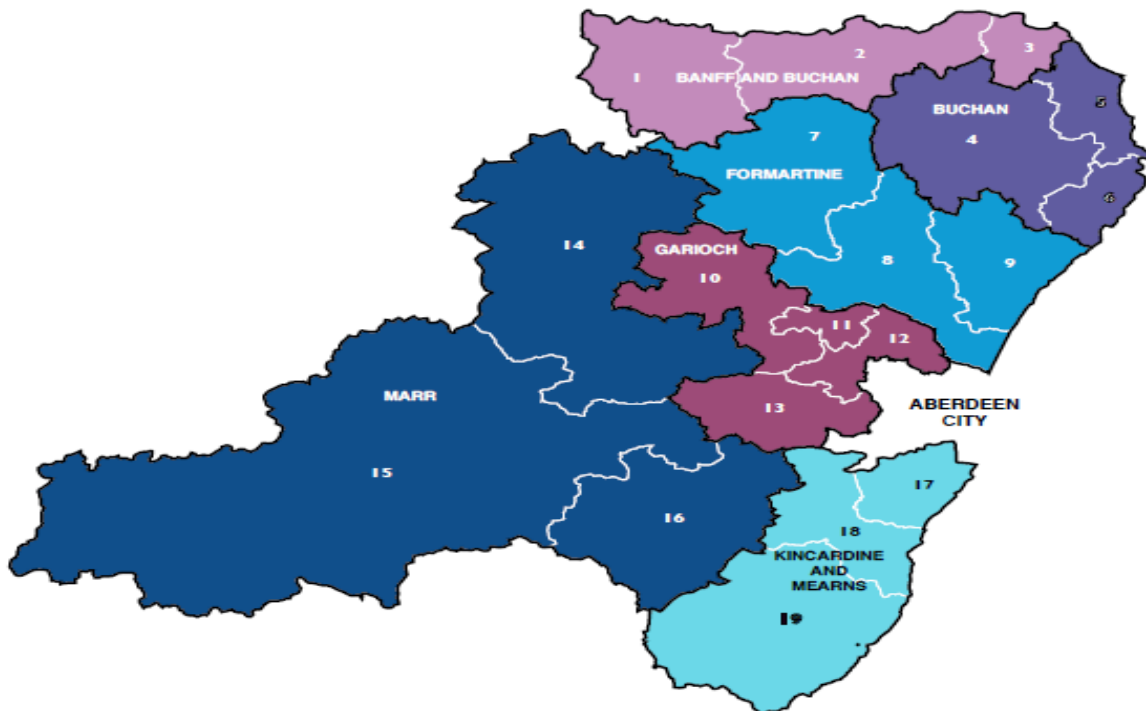

Where additional information is required, please ensure that all material which is to be submitted alongside your application is securely attached to the form. It is recommended that you retain a copy of your application for your records. No responsibility will be taken for items lost or delayed in the post. A written acknowledgement will be sent to you on receipt of your application.

Validation Process

When your application is received it will be:-

- (a) Acknowledged in writing.

- (b) Validated to ensure that the information provided is accurate and that the reason for funding is in line with the trust purposes.
- (c) If it is valid the application will be presented before the trustees at the next meeting of the Trust.
- (d) If the application is rejected, the Area Manager will write to the applicant with an explanation of the outcome.

WE ENDEAVOUR TO VALIDATE EACH APPLICATION WITHIN 2 WEEKS FROM THE DATE THAT THE APPLICATION IS RECEIVED WITH THE AIM OF PROVIDING A DECISION REGARDING THE OUTCOME OF THE VALIDATION PROCESS WITHIN A PERIOD OF 8 WEEKS.

Please Note: the final decision on the validity of an application will be taken by the Trustees in consultation with the appropriate legal and financial advisors.

Meeting of the Trust

If the application is valid, the application will be presented to the Trustees at the next meeting of the Trust. The applicant or in the case of a company or organisation, the individual who submitted the application on behalf of the company or organisation, will be invited to attend the Trust meeting.

Where an application for funding is being heard at a meeting of the Trust, this meeting will not be open to the public.

Where the applicant has requested an opportunity to speak to the application in the meeting, he or she will have a permitted period of up to five minutes, or any other period as may be determined by the Chair, to speak. An appropriate period of time will be allocated whereby any of the Trustees may ask a question regarding the application.

Where the applicant does not wish to speak, the Chair will allow an appropriate period for the Trustees to ask any relevant questions that relate to the application presented.

Once all questions regarding the application have been concluded, the Trustees will discuss the application before them.

Once the application has been discussed, a decision will then be made to:

- (a) Approve the application and provide funding the applicant.
- (b) Reject the application, or,
- (c) Instruct some further action (if this is required).

The Area Manager will then write to the applicant within ten working days providing a formal statement of the outcome of the Hearing.

Please Note: that the Trust's decision is final and cannot be appealed.
