- 1 Cheques or Postal Orders should be made payable to Aberdeenshire Council.
- 2 Consents have a validity of seven days, during which time the work must be either completed or substantially begun.
- 3 Submission of this application gives no authority for the work to commence. Applicants must wait until permission has been granted and must also be in possession of any other necessary consents, for example planning permission for works that constitute development.
- 4 Attention is drawn to the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 Section 109.
- 5 In accordance with the same Act the applicant will be liable for maintenance of the permanent reinstatement for 24 months (36 months if excavation is deeper than 1.5 metres) and will incur additional fee(s) to cover administration costs and inspections carried out by Aberdeenshire Council where defects come to light.
- 6 Aberdeenshire Council should be contacted by phoning the appropriate local office above prior to commencing the works on site and the "Notification of Permanent Reinstatement" should be returned within a week of completion.
- 7 The contractor for the work must possess the appropriate certificate of competence in the excavation of work in accordance with the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 - "Specification for the Reinstatement of Openings in Highways".
- 8 Evidence of Plant Information is required for a permit to be issued. Either prints of utility sketches to be presented or a PIR ref no from Symology 'Dial Before You Dig' 08000-231-251.
