I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 1 - Banff and District. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 9,185 and the number of ballot papers received was 4,002 giving a percentage turnout of $43.6 \%$. There were 34 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 993.
