I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 4 - Central Buchan. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 11,170 and the number of ballot papers received was 4,742 giving a percentage turnout of $42.5 \%$. There were 85 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 932 .
