## Contest Name

Ward 16 - Banchory and Mid Deeside

I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 16 - Banchory and Mid Deeside. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 9,105 and the number of ballot papers received was 4,870 giving a percentage turnout of $53.5 \%$. There were 38 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,209 .
