



Wild Camping

Wild camping can take place on unenclosed land where access rights apply, but only where it is respectful of other countryside users and does not harm the environment.


Wild camping is:

- Accessed on foot or cycle
- Light weight, one or two person tents either singly or in pairs

Wild camping is not:

- Accessed from a vehicle
- Large or family style tents
- Groups of tents or gazebos

Camping which is not wild camping is not permitted under responsible access rights and should take place in a designated campsite only.
