B9032, MEMSIE - PROPOSED 40MPH SPEED LIMIT

Due to new developments on the north side of the B9032, Aberdeenshire Council are satisfied that it is necessary in the interests of road safety to extend the existing 40mph speed limit on the B9032, Muir Road from the eastern part of Memsie, by a further 201 metres to the east, to a point to the east of the access for the new developments on the north side of the B9032.



MEMSIE - PROPOSED 40MPH SPEED LIMIT

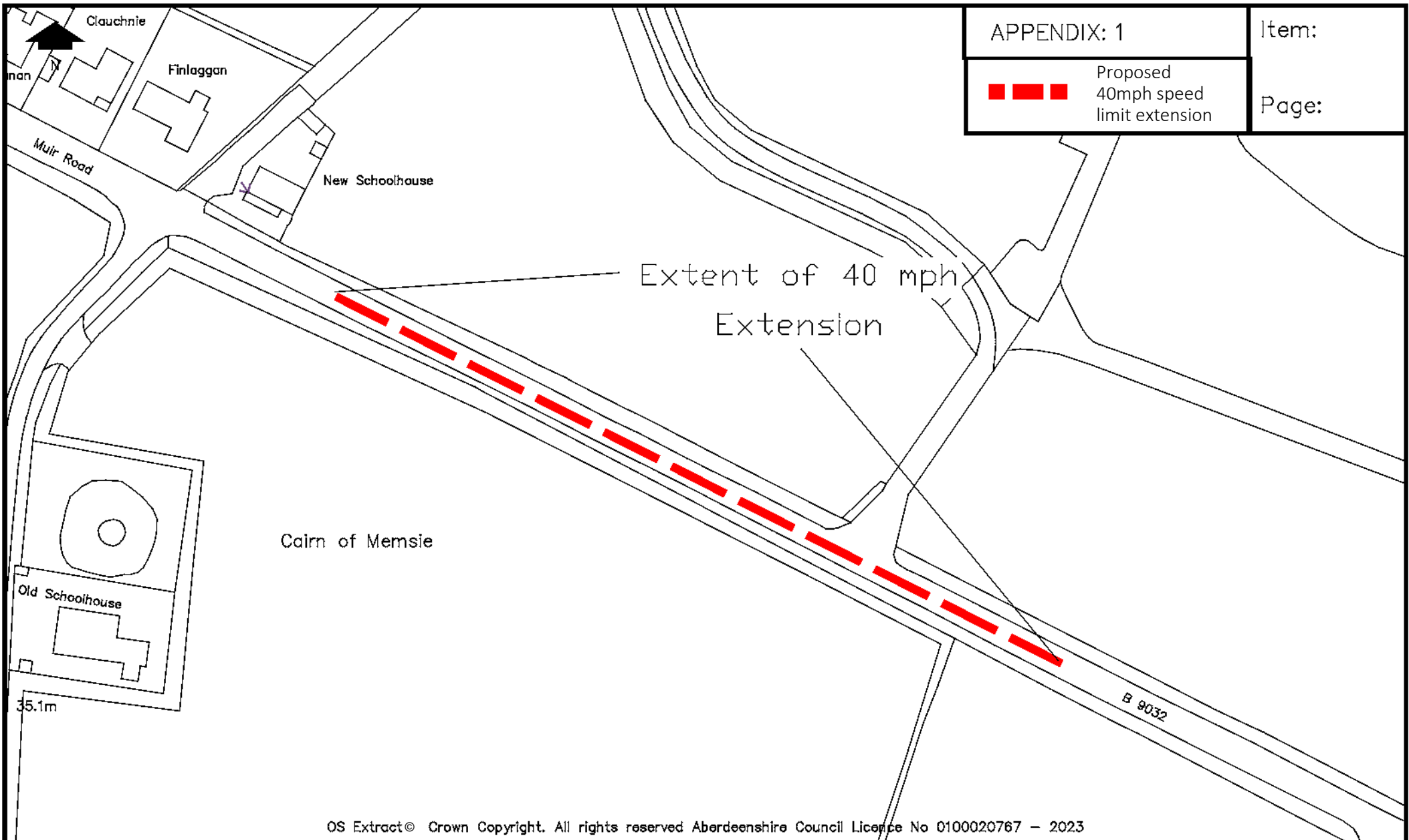
Aberdeenshire Council proposes to make “The Aberdeenshire Council (B9032, Memsie) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2023” under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The effect of the order will be to extend the existing 40mph speed limit on the B9032, Muir Road from the eastern part of Memsie, by a further 201 metres to the east, to a point to the east of the access for the new developments on the north side of the B9032.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

THE ABERDEENSHIRE COUNCIL (B9032, MEMSIE) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

Aberdeenshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

1. This order may be cited as “The Aberdeenshire Council (B9032, Memsie) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2023”, and shall come into operation on
2. No person shall drive, or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order, at a speed exceeding 40mph.
