ST CYRUS - PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council is satisfied that the implementation of the proposed Zebra crossing will provide a safer means of crossing the A92 St Cyrus. The crossing has been assessed in line with the Pedestrian Crossing Assessment Policy where it met the criteria for the introduction of a zebra crossing.



ST CYRUS - PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to introduce a zebra crossing in St Cyrus under Chapter 27, Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

Zebra crossing location - A92 St Cyrus from a point 3 metres north of the extended north kerb line of Ecclesgreig Road to a point 6 metres north of the extended north kerbline of Beach Road.
