



Dear Sir,

I write to express my dismay at the Revised Spatial Framework for Wind Energy Development. The level of protection for the environment and communities across Aberdeenshire has been very significantly reduced and this will lead to a deluge of new applications. Many of these might be rejected in the detailed planning process but there will be appeals and then re-submissions if the appeals are not successful. This produces significant stress on the planning system, communities and other residents living close to the applications. The opportunity to have a clear and comprehensive guideline as to where turbine were likely to approved (or not) has been lost as a result of a misguided policy decision from the Scottish government.

My further observation is that is manifestly unfair to protect settlements (how are these defined?) and not individual dwellings. It seems likely this will be open to legal challenge at some point.
