



MACDUFF - PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to introduce a zebra crossing in Macduff under Chapter 27, Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

Zebra crossing location - B9026 Duff Street, Macduff from a point 1 metre south of the extended south kerb line of Barnhill Road to a point 50 metres north of the extended north kerb line of Barnhill Road.
