	Service Provided	Fee
1.	<u>General.</u> A charge is made per officer hour spent at the place of submission of the equipment for the purposes of examination, adjustment, testing or retesting of the equipment. It should be noted that the time taken should be quoted on the account and should not include any time spent on research. The charge is £116.25 per hour for a Trading Standards Officer. Plus an additional £74.25 per hour for a Technical Assistant if required.	£116.25/hr £74.25/hr
2.	<u>Out of Hours Work</u> Where work is required to be carried out at weekends, public holidays or outside the hours 07:30 to 18:30 there will be a supplement of 50% of the standard hourly rate.	
3.	<u>Equipment Provided</u> Where by prior arrangement facilities in the form of manpower and/or relevant testing equipment are provided by the party submitting the item(s) a discount of up to 40% of the fee can be made. This discount is at the discretion of the Trading Standards Manager and will include situations where the party submitting the items provide a weighbridge testing truck.	
4.	<u>Calibration Certificate</u> In all cases where a calibration certificate is required an additional fee of £47.75 will be charged.	£47.75
5.	<u>Weights and Measures 1985 Public Weighbridge Operator Certificate</u> First public weighbridge operator – examination and certification of operator Second and subsequent weighbridge operator – examination and certification of operator at same premises on the same occasion	£104.00 (See note 2) £58.50
6.	<u>Cancellation</u> In all cases where a test is cancelled when an officer is on site a charge shall be levied based on officer time for travel and on site at the standard hourly rate.
