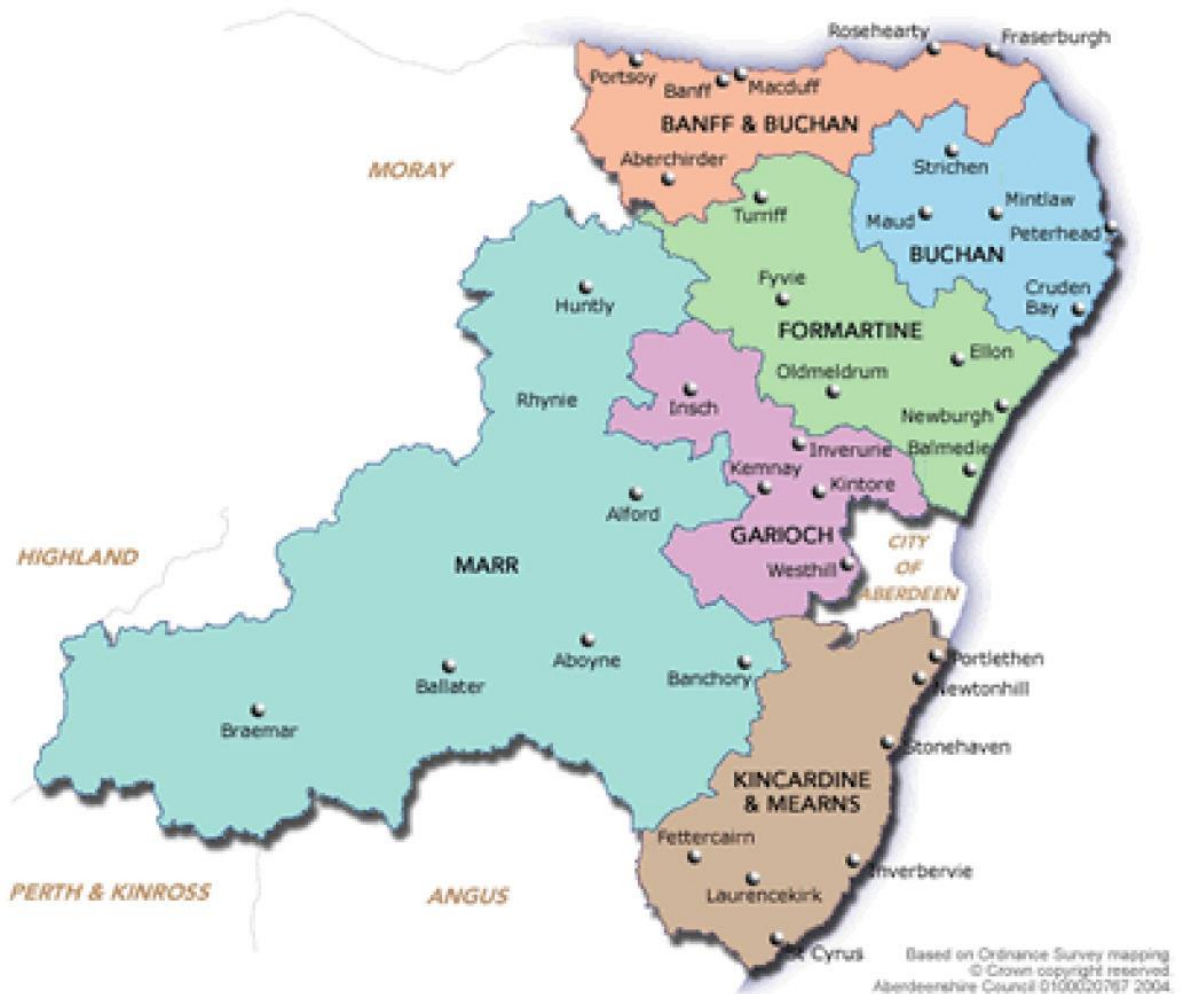

Subject to the following conditions:

1. Consents have a validity of seven days, during which time the work must be either completed or substantially begun.
2. Submission of this application gives no authority for the work to commence. Applicants must wait until permission has been granted and must also be in possession of any other necessary consents, for example planning permission for works that constitute development.
3. Attention is drawn to the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 Section 109.
4. Following amendments to the “Road Works (Reinstatement) (Scotland) Regulations 1992” which took effect from 1 October 2023, the applicant is to be responsible for the maintenance of permanent reinstatements for 6 years and will incur additional fee(s) to cover administration costs and inspections carried out by Aberdeenshire Council.
5. Aberdeenshire Council should be contacted at the appropriate local office above prior to commencing the works on site and the “*Notification of Permanent Reinstatement*” should be returned within a week of completion.
6. The contractor for the work must possess the appropriate certificate of competence in the excavation of work in accordance with the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 - “Specification for the Reinstatement of Openings in Highways”.
7. Evidence of Plant Information is required for a permit to be issued. Either prints of utility sketches to be presented or a PIR ref no from Symology ‘Dial Before You Dig’ 08000-231-251.
