

STONEHAVEN - PROPOSED PEDEX CROSSING

Aberdeenshire Council proposes to introduce a PEDEX crossing in Stonehaven under Chapter 27, Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

PEDEX crossing location - B979 Bridge of Cowie, Stonehaven from a point 44 metres north of the extended east kerb line of Belmont Brae to a point 106 metres north of the extended east kerb line of Belmont Brae.
